As many of you are already aware, we received word that a crew member who works with our partner studio, Cinespace Chicago Film Studios, has tested positive for COVID-19.

The safety of our cast and crew is our top priority, and we are working closely with our medical experts and public health officials to ensure best practices. Tonight, we are taking the necessary precaution of performing a deep cleaning of the set as well as all common areas. This sanitization process will enable us to safely continue production as planned. In addition, we will be scheduling a similar deep clean procedure several times each week moving forward.

However, if anyone is not feeling well:

- Please do not come to work
- Alert your line producer or department head
- Work directly with your medical provider for next steps

As a reminder, below are basic guidelines to help all of us stay healthy year-round:

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth -- they are direct entry points for viruses. Use a tissue or wash your hands first.
